PITCHING REGULATIONS

A team may not use more then two, 12 year old pitchers in any week.

A team may not use more then five pitchers in any game.

If a boy pitches in four or more innings on any day, he must have three full days rest before he may pitch again.

If a boy pitches in less then four innings on any day, he must have one full day rest before he may pitch again.

A boy may not pitch in more then six innings during any week.

If a boy is removed from the mound during a game, he may not pitch again in that game. He may, however, continue in the game in any other position.

In the Minor League, 12 year olds may not pitch. Otherwise the rules are the same.

These pitching regulations are designed to protect the physical and mental health of the boys, by insuring that no boy does too much pitching. They explain why a Manager must sometimes remove a good pitcher during a game.

The refreshment stand at the Gulfport Lions Little League Field is operated by the Mother's Auxiliary. All profits from the stand go directly into maintenance and improvement of the field and buildings and into operation of the League. Mothers who can donate their time one eveing a week are needed. See any member of the Auxiliary.

Most boys who are selected for a regular Little League team have had one or more years of Minor League experience. Gulfport boys within the age limits may join the Minor League anytime during the season. Any League officer will provide an Application and information.

In the 14 years of its existance, close to (estimated) 1,000 boys have participated in its activities. Hundreds of adult volunteers have contributed freely of their time and skills to its work.

GULFPORT LIONS LITTLE LEAGUE field is one of the finest youth baseball fields in the South. The buildings, the stands, the lights, even the sod of the playing field have been constructed and are maintained entirely by volunteer workers. Much of the material has been donated by others who believe in the basic principles of Little League.

This season, the financial and manpower resources of the League have been taxed almost to the limit by the necessity of replacing the hurricane damaged roofs over the stands, and by other necessary improvements and repairs. Any friend of the League who cares to help with this work, financially, may make checks payable to "Gulfport Lions Little League, Inc., and hand them to any officer of the League. Such donations may be treated as "contributions" in figuring income tax.
