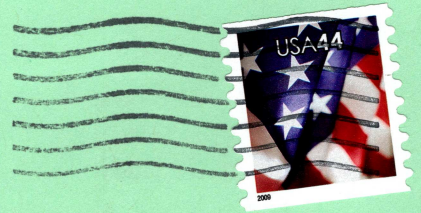
She's At it Again!
