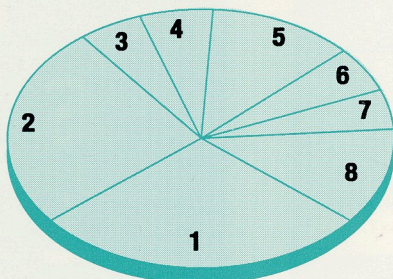

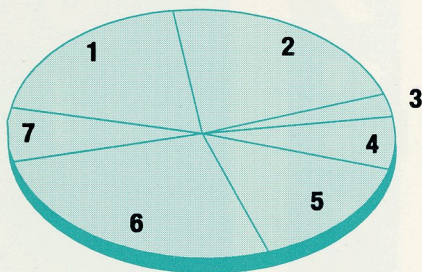
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## REVENUES BY SOURCE

# Fiscal Year 1994 Administrative Activities and 1995 Goals

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## 1994 Results

- Upgraded 352 lights as part of a citywide street lighting improvement program.
- Purchased a new state of the art fire pumper truck and significantly increased minimum housing and standards inspections citywide.
- Completed the 7th Avenue improvement project, which included construction of the last unpaved street in the city and upgrades to water lines in the northern section of the city.
- Established a bicycle route for school children and installed a police bicycle patrol.

## 1995 Goals

- Increase the number of uniformed police officers and fire fighters, and formalize a problem oriented patrol program.
- Commence construction on the 49th Street South intersection improvements at 15th and 11th Avenues South by widening the roadway and adding turning lanes.
- Implement a new 800 MHZ radio system and revise procedures to accommodate the new police facility.
- Inform city residents on disaster response procedures and update demographic information for post disaster funding applications.

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## 1994 Results

- Completed the library expansion and renovation project, which added patron parking and nearly doubled the size of the facility.
- Commenced work on the Osgood Point restoration and habitat enhancement project in partnership with State, Regional and local environmental agencies and groups.
- Purchased a new bus for the Gulfport Extended Mini-Bus Service (GEMS) and provided over 16,000 trips for residents.
- Cleaned, televised and sealed over 42,000 feet of sewer pipe.

## 1995 Goals

- Continue providing comprehensive community services to residents with summer jobs for teens, after school and tot time programs, and senior citizen activities.
- Commence work on the construction phase of the marina improvement plan, which will provide new slips with upgraded electrical and water amenities.
- Complete Osgood Point restoration and commence work on the Gulfport beach renourishment project by adding over 2.5 acres of dry beach and reducing stormwater erosion.
- Adopt a stormwater utility and curbside recycling program.

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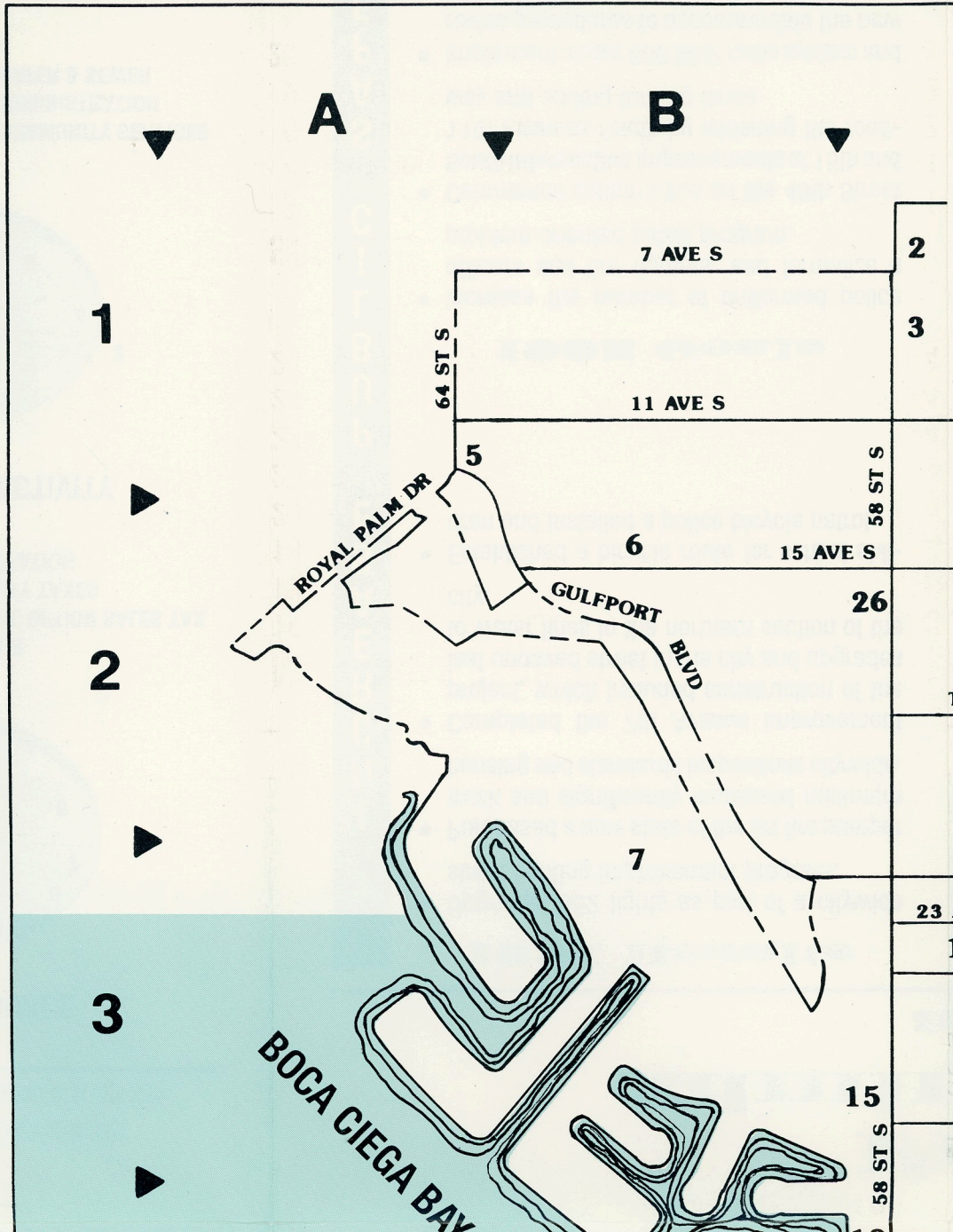
## 1994 Results

- Implemented third year of the citywide sidewalk improvement program by replacing over 5,200 linear feet of sidewalks and adding 50 new handicapped ramps.
- Enforced the newly adopted tree preservation ordinance and applied over 7,300 gallons of dust control in the city alleys.
- Commenced work on Phase II of the City's redevelopment program with intersection and stormwater improvements, and commercial/residential rehabilitation grants.
- Renovated the Gulfport Casino and reconstructed the seawall behind the Community Center.

## 1995 Goals

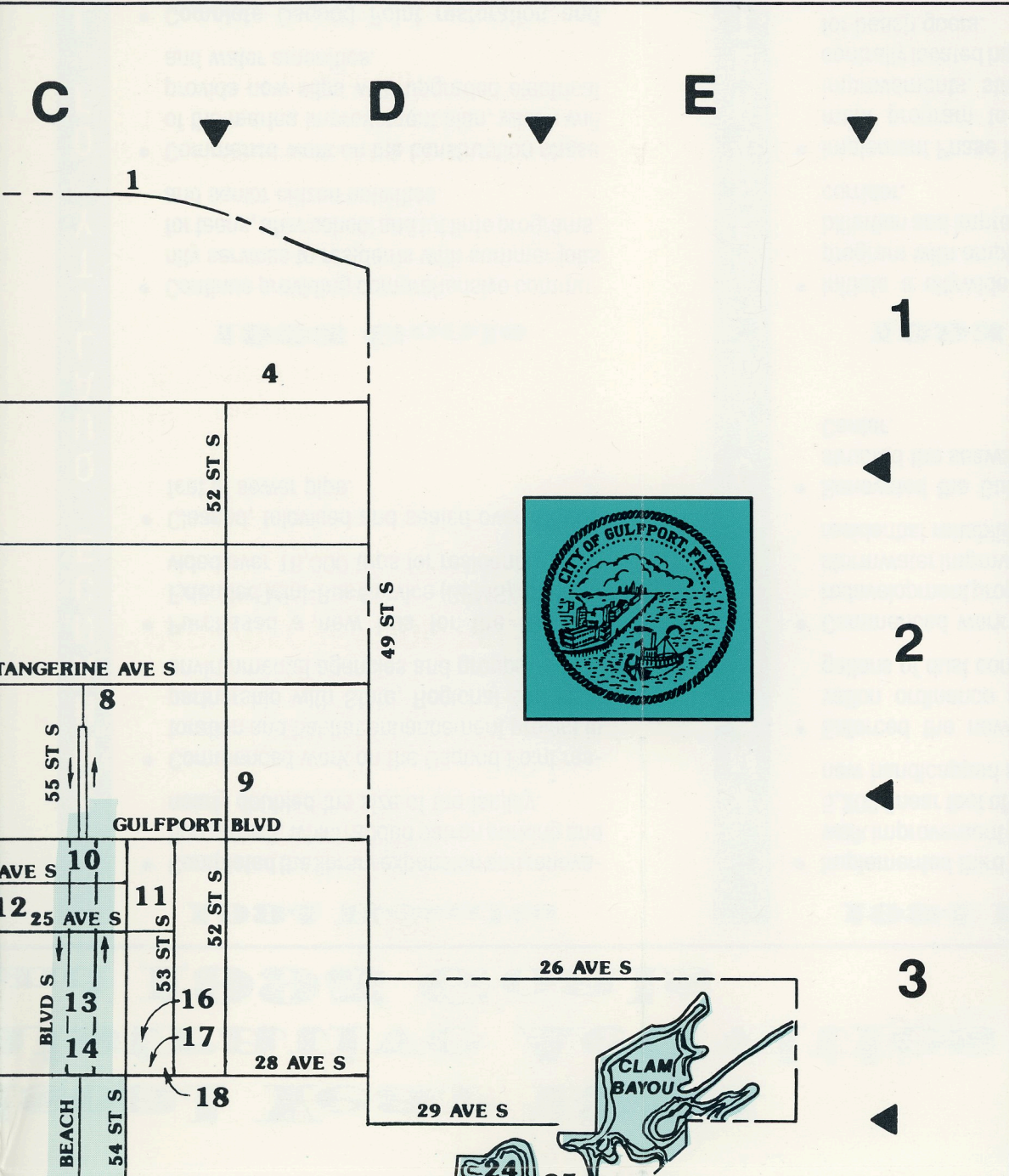
- Initiate a citywide economic development program with emphasis on residential rehabilitation and improvement to the 49th Street corridor.
- Implement Phase III of the City's redevelopment program to include beach parking improvements, street resurfacing and new centrally located handicap restroom facilities for beach goers.
- Complete the final phase of work on the new Municipal Complex project.
- Resurface 17 city streets and develop a more permanent multi-year alley improvement program.

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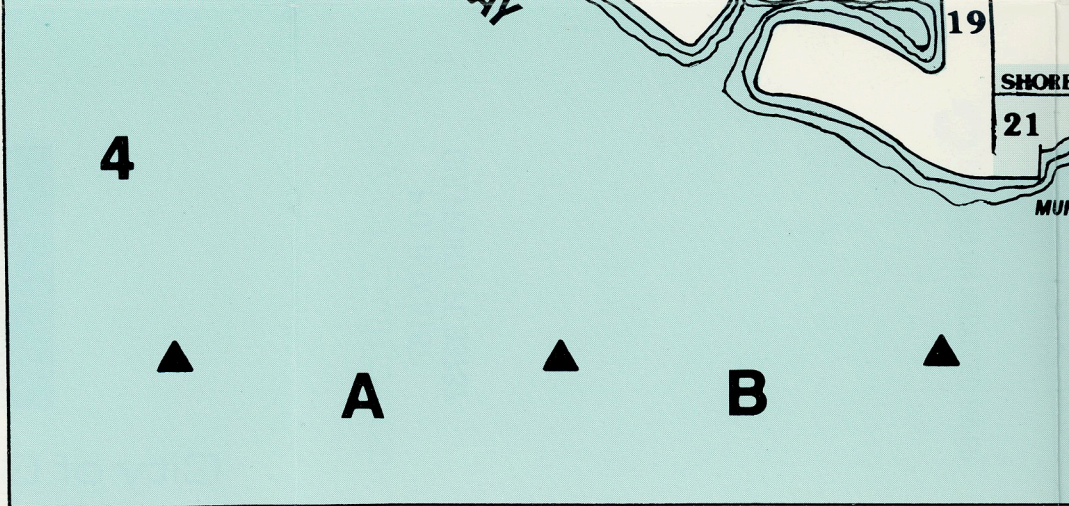

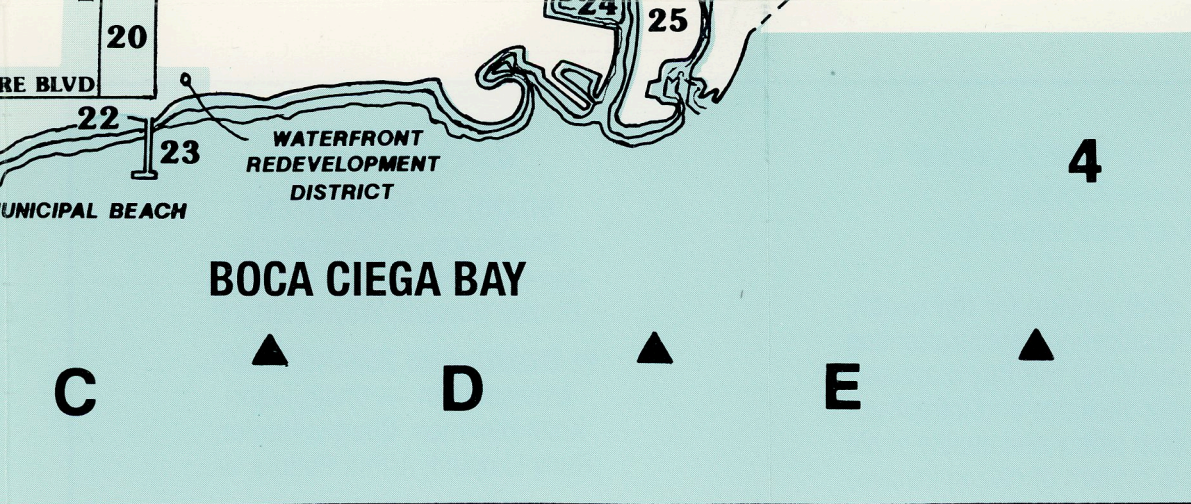
