

A piece of our past

This photograph shows East Third Street looking toward Mulberry Street and was taken in the spring of 1958. In addition to the now-classic cars plying the roads, a number of businesses which are either long gone or relocated are visible, including the Busy Bee Lunch at left and Williamsport Saddlery, right, which eventually became Willard's Saddlery in Loyalsock Township. Also prominent are the building at left which was recently razed, and at right, the sign for the Edwards Lakes-to-Sea bus terminal. The terminal was destroyed by fire in December 1975 and was subsequently rebuilt. Part of the spire of First Presbyterian Church also is visible at right. Farther down the street, at left, were two funerals homes: Page's at 125 E. Third St. and Crouse's at 133 E. Third St. Page's is long gone, but Crouse's continues to operate.
