MARYLAND AND DISTRICT OF COLUMBIACHICKENS AND TURKEYS ON FARMS

The importance of chickens and turkeys in Maryland is indicated by a special report of the 1935 Federal Farm Census released today by Director William L. Austin of the Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce. Chickens over 3 months old numbered 3,589,071 on January 1, 1935 and were reported on 39,416, or 88.8 percent of all the farms in the State. During the calendar year 1934, the production of chicken eggs totaled 21,064,915 dozens and the number of chickens raised was 7,030,654. Carroll, Baltimore, and Frederick were the three leading counties in the number of chickens on hand and the production of eggs. Carroll ranked first, Worcester, second, and Caroline, third, in the number of chickens raised. Turkeys over 3 months of age numbered 74,068 on January 1, 1935 and were reported on 9,858, or 22.2 percent of all the farms in the State. Queen Annes, Talbot, and Kent were the three leading counties in the number of turkeys on hand.

Chickens over 3 months old in the District of Columbia totaled 13,780 on January 1, 1935. During the calendar year 1934 the production of chicken eggs amounted to 106,869 dozens and the number of chickens raised was 15,999.
