

9. Box: Emma Bray Cohen: 1884 Wedding Documents & Letters

1. Feb 28, 1884: Wedding license Alfred Henry Cohen and Emma Bray; original
2. Feb 20 : Invoice from B. Nathan and Co.; Crockery, China, and Glassware; 126-130 Sutter St, San Francisco; dinnerware items ordered
3. Mar 5 : Receipt for honeymoon expenses at Hotel Del Monte, Monterey, California; board \$35, stable \$10, lunches, .50, telegrams \$1.20-total due \$46.70
4. Feb : Small brown book with alphabetical list of guests invited to wedding; back of book lists wedding gifts.
5. Feb : Handwritten list of presents
6. Feb 23, 1884: Newspaper clipping with wedding announcement including guest list and typed transcription of the article
7. Jun 3, 1897: Newspaper clipping "A quartet of early June weddings" includes 'Miss Emilie Ethel Cohen and Lt Charles Lyman Bent'; [Ethel was sister to Alfred Henry Cohen
8. Jul 30, 1971 :Letter from Leonard Verbarg, Oakland Tribune to Emelita Cohen responding to request for photo copy of 1884 wedding announcement; no copies attached
9. Letter from Emma's friend Nellie Bacon to Emma's cousin Effie recounting details of the preparation and presentation of the wedding quilt made by Emma's friends and family. And an accounting of the wedding ceremony.
10. Collection of four letters to Emma's cousin Effie recounting details of the wedding ceremony from friends Cousin Mame Beans, Sister Julie Bray, Friend Florence Pope, and friend Mary.
 - A: From Mame Beans, a cousin of Emma's; dated 3 Mar 1884
 - B: From Mary a childhood friend & neighbor of Emma's dated 5 Mar 1884
 - C: From Florence Pope, a Mills College classmate of Emma's dated 2 Mar 1884
 - D: From Julie Bray [presumed], Emma's sister dated 3 Mar 1884
