

Box 30 Douglas Bray Cohen Correspondence and Ephemera

- Season tickets to 'all meets and games' on the University of California Berkeley campus Fall/Spring semester 1916. Postmark Dec 9, 1915 with 'World's Panorama-Pacific Exposition, San Francisco stamp cancellation.
- Typed letter dated Dec 4, 1961 to Molly Lohse from Walt Keister, manager, Agricultural Division. Referring to Douglas B Cohen as 'an old boyhood friend'.
- Typed poem "Frontier Boys Trek of 1948" with handwritten note to 'Monsignor Cohen'
- 'Salary, Douglas B. Cohen' Jun 30, 1940 to Jan 1, 1950; handwritten
- Typed letter dated Apr 2, 1959 referring to the 'Trust Agreement'
- Typed letter dated Nov 17, 1970 from Douglas Bray Cohen to Barbara and Bill Donald, Mardi and Don Schma explaining his requests for his cremation and burial.
