1. Photo copy of handwritten memories of Emilie Cohen by Emelita Cohen
2. Handwritten letter from Emilie to AA (?) from Dresden, dated Jan 13, 1878
3. Emilie G. Cohen's typewritten account of her experience of the San Francisco earthquake, Apr 18, 1906 from her home at Fernside, Alameda. [a copy of this account is also in Box 50 with other family accounts of quake]
4. "Heart-Faith" Sermon by W. H. Furness, First Unitarian Church in Philadelphia, dated Nov 11, 1894. Note from Emilie with quote from Dr Furness a diff sermon?
5. Handwritten copy of a poem
6. Handwritten copy of hymn "Rock of Ages"
7. One page of handwritten letter from E.G. Cohen with travel plans: "I go to NY on Wed May 8th, leave NY Thursday May 9th at 5:30 pm due in San Francisco Mon 13th at 7:28 pm."
8. Letter to Emilie dated Feb 25, 1880 from address 142 East 80th Street, NY; cannot decipher sender signature
9. Handwritten note: "Happy is the man who in his western home Spans time and space and finds himself in Rome"
10. Three dates torn from daily calendar: March 24, 26, and 27 no year
11. Two handwritten letters to Emilie from her brother in law Henry Cohen date looks like 1866
12. Typewritten letter to Edie (Edith Cohen) from Henry Gibbons, her grandfather, dated Oct 31, 1877
13. Handwritten Diary pages covering dates Jan 1-Feb 28, 1900 while Emilie is on a trip to visit her family in Wilmington, Delaware. Mentions death of her sister Rebecca 45 years prior, visiting family graves, family notes
14. Empty envelope addressed to Mrs E.G. Cohen, cannot read postmark; pencil note says 'death of AAC'.
15. Handwritten poems presumed author writer Emilie Cohen; sepia notepaper; 4 pp
16. Handwritten poems presumed author Emilie Cohen; sepia tone note paper with "Fernside" at top and monogram "EGC" in left corner, 1 page both sides
17. "*Runnymede*" hymn handwritten on sepia tone note paper; says at bottom "Hymn written by Joyce Greer Harrison in honor of Emilie Ethel Cohen which was sung at her wedding, Jun 2, 1894"
18. 3x4 published card with poem "Life's Mirror"; no date
19. "The Poet Philosopher" by Walt Mason; clipping from unknown newspaper
20. "The Blackberry Girl" by Voltaire; typed on three pages
21. Letter to Emilie Gibbons Cohen to Emma Bray Cohen, March 1907 both handwritten original copy and typed transcription in the sleeve
22. "Christmas presents received by Mrs Cohen" 1922; handwritten list 2 pages

23. "A happy new year 1915" printed pamphlet from Goldberg, Bowen, & Co. with printed message from Robert W. Service
 24. A.A. Cohen's death personal memoirs of Emilie Gibbons Cohen, handwritten original eleven page recollections of the tragic event Nov 16, 1887
 25. Hardback journal, black with brown spine, lined inside with stamped page numbers; includes excerpts from other works copied by Emilie Cohen and perhaps some original poems; dates 1884-1886
 26. Hardback journal matches above; includes handwritten chronology of AA Cohen's death written by Emilie Cohen; handwritten copy of autopsy report 1887
