Information Wanted of Seeley Family

Ebenezer Seeley, born Stamford, Conn., January 18, 1696-7. Will proved March 7, 1767, Goshen, N. Y.

Married Mercy Decur, Stamford, Conn., Jan. 22, 1718-9.—1st wife.

Married Eunice (?) Where? When? Her will proved, Dec. 5, 1769, Goshen, N. Y.—2nd wife.

Resided in Orange County in 1744. Children—

1. Jonas, born Sept. 17, 1719, married Sarah Bartlett. When? Where?

2. Ebenezer, born March 19, 1720, married Ann Gregory, 1740. Where?

3. Mercy, born April 19, 1723, not married.

4. Bezaeel, born August 20, 1725—married?

5. Isreal, born Sept. 4, 1727—married?

6. Susanna, born Jan. 4, 1729, married James Sayre 1749. Where?

7. Nathaniel, born October 11, 1732—married?

8. Samuel, born Sept. 10, 1734; died Feb. 24, 1735.

9. Josiah, born Sept. 22, 1736; married Abigail Smith, 1757; died August 28, 1808.

10. Thaddeus, born Feb. 21, 1738; married Joanna Seeley, when? Her birth and death dates?

11. John, born July 10, 1742; married? Date of death?

Ebenezer Seeley, Stamford, Conn., was 4th generation from Capt. Robert Seeley, who settled in Connecticut. Ebenezer 4, Jonas 3, Abachiah 2, Robert 1.
