

Marrin History

The grandfather of the emigrants (Reinold and Matthew) is the first Marrin mentioned in the Marrin Genealogy pub. 1904.

This was Rynald Mervyn b. about 1514, m. Johan- and had six children. He owned several estates in Ramsey a village in Tendinghun- dred, 68 miles north of London, 3 miles west of Warwick, all being in the county of Essex.

In Rynald's will, (made Dec. 22, 1554 and still preserved in Somerset House, London) he directs his body to be buried in the church of St. Michael the Archangel which still stands in the eastern part of Ramsey, anciently known as Michaelstown.

The second child of Rynald & Johan Marrin was Edward, b. about 1552, in Ramsey or Wabness. He married Margaret

Edward d. Nov. 14, 1615. He, after his marriage lived at Great Bentley (10 miles south west of Ramsey). They had 11 children of whom the 9th, Reinold, b. Oct. 1594 and the 11th, Matthew, b. March 1600, were the two who came to America and were the founders of the name in this country.
