


KNOW YOUR WILDFLOWER

Learning the name of a wildflower can be like shaking its hand: you'll be friends for life. Here are some features to look for when trying to identify a species.

Bloom Color

Major color groups include white, yellow, orange, brown, red, pink, purple, and blue.

Leaves

Leaves can be simple  or compound . Within these broad categories, leaves have many different arrangements.

Flower Structure

Flower structures vary wildly. They can be radially symmetrical , daisy-like , or bilaterally symmetrical . Flowers can also have rounded clusters  or elongated clusters .
