

This Indenture made the Twenty eighth day of September  
 in the year of our Lord 1692 in the fourth year  
 of the reigns of our Sovereign Lord & Lady William and Mary  
 by the Grace of God King & Queen over England &c.  
 Between John Stillwell Esq. High Sheriff, of the County of  
 Richmond on the one part, And, Abraham Laskman Esq.  
 Pillau, Garott Vigneton John Morgan Esq. Laskman  
 = holders of the said County of the other. It Witnesseth  
 by Virtue of their <sup>high</sup> writ to me Sirs Rod. for  
 choice of Burgesses of the aforesaid County, to serve in  
 Gen: Assembly for their <sup>high</sup> Province and Territory of  
 New York and its Dependence, the freeholders of said County  
 of Richmond assembled at the Courthouse of said County  
 and by their free vote made choice of John Tunison and  
 Thomas Morgan freeholders of said County to be Burgesses  
 for the said County of Richmond, And were by the said John  
 Stillwell High Sheriff as aforesaid directed to attend their  
<sup>high</sup> service at Fort William Henry upon the twenty  
 fourth day of October next ensuing, according to the said writ  
 to assist in the service of the said Assembly as aforesaid, In  
 Testimony whereof the said John Stillwell Sheriff and the  
 said Abraham Laskman Esq. Pillau, Garott Vigneton John  
 Morgan Esq. Laskman freeholders of said County, have  
 hereunto set their hands & seals the day years first  
 above written.
