 will and Testament, of Jacob Peterson late of this City deced^t
 in a plea of trespass on the Case with pledges of, And thereupon
 the said Friedrich by John Fisher his Attorney saith, That
 who was the the said Jacob Peterson in his life time and the
 above said Maritid his then wife, was indebted the twenty
 fifth day of October in the year of our Lord God One thousand
 six hundred eighty and four here at New York within the
 Dockward of this City was indebted unto him the said Friedrich
 in the full and just sum of two pounds seven shillings
 and five pence Curr^t money of New York. It being for sundry
 goods and Merchandizes before that time by him the said
 Friedrich sold and delivered to him the said Jacob, and the
 above said Maritid his then wife, And being so indebted to
 the said Jacob in his life time, to witt the day and year above said
 at New York aforesaid, did assume upon him selfe and to the
 said Friedrich faithfully did promise the said sum of two pound
 seven shillings and five pence to the said Friedrich
 well and truly to satisfie Content and pay whenever they should
 be thereunto required yett never the loss the said Jacob in his
 life time, his promise and assumption aforesaid
 Regarding, but fraudulently intending the
 that behalfe craftily to deceive the said sum of two pound
 seven shillings and five pence to the said Friedrich
 hath not paid, Neither hath the said Maritid in the time
 of her widdow hood, Nor the said Barnard and Maritid his
 wife since their Intermarriage satisfied and paid the said sum
 although often they were by the said Friedrich they have been required
 but the same to pay they have refused and still doe refuse
 to the Damage of the said Friedrich five pounds and
 thereof he brings suite &c.
