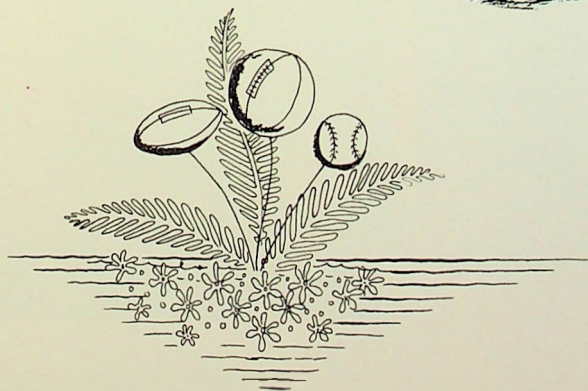
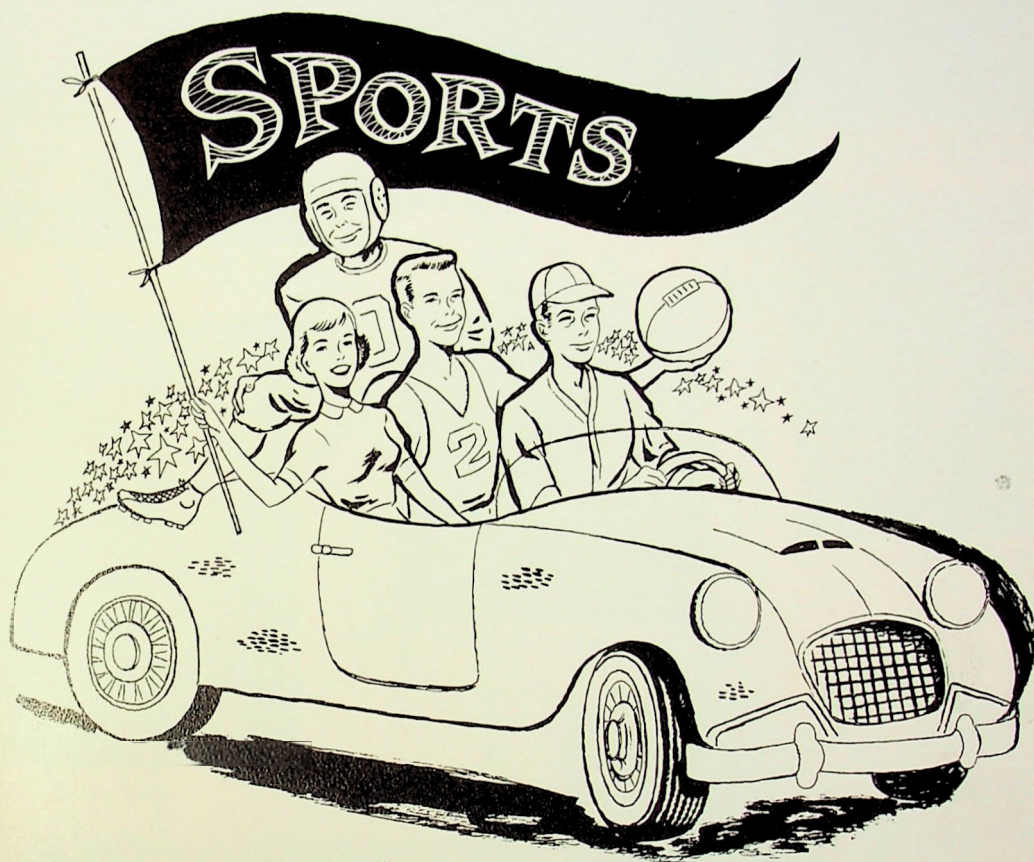
Water, Water everywhere and not a drop to drink.

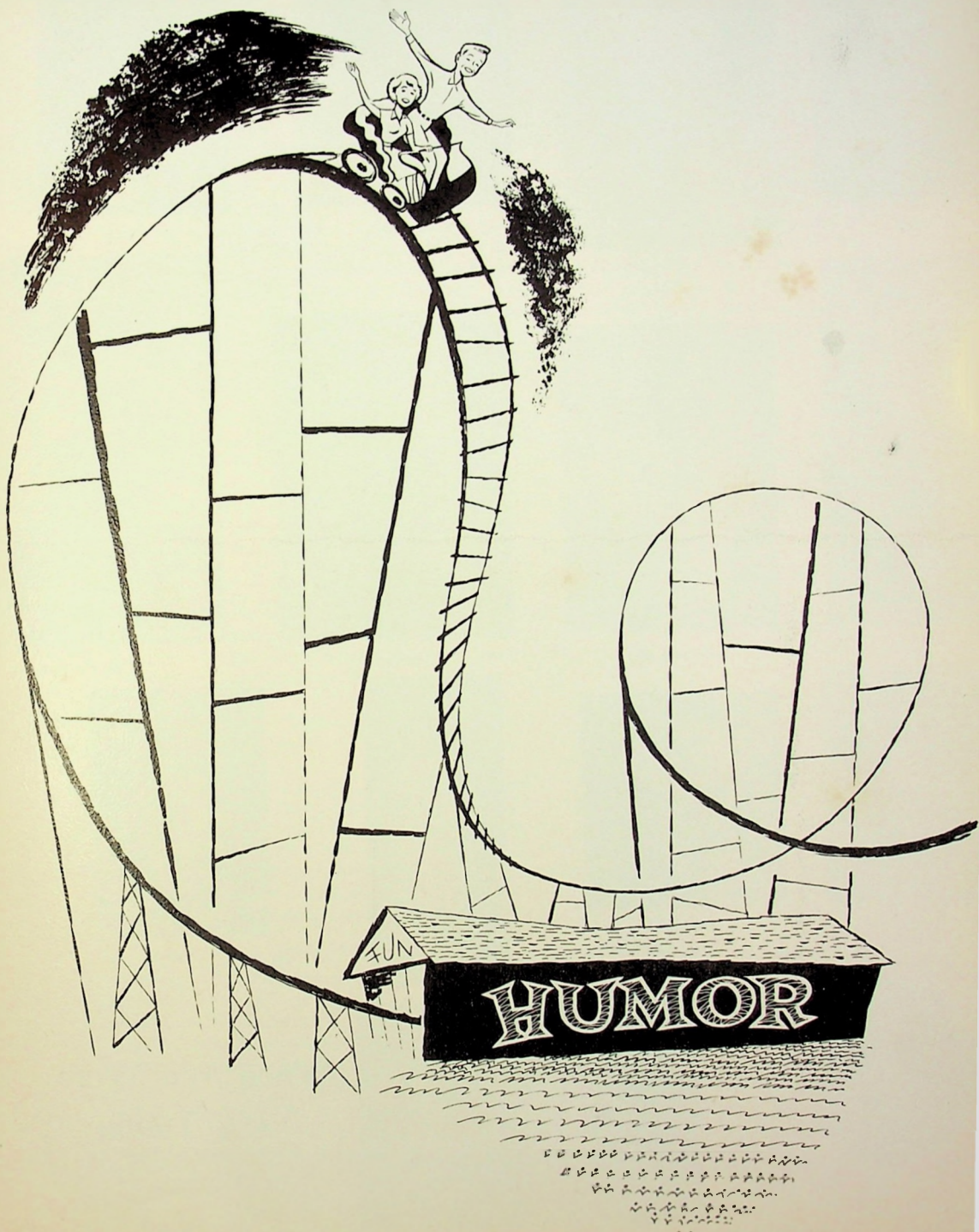

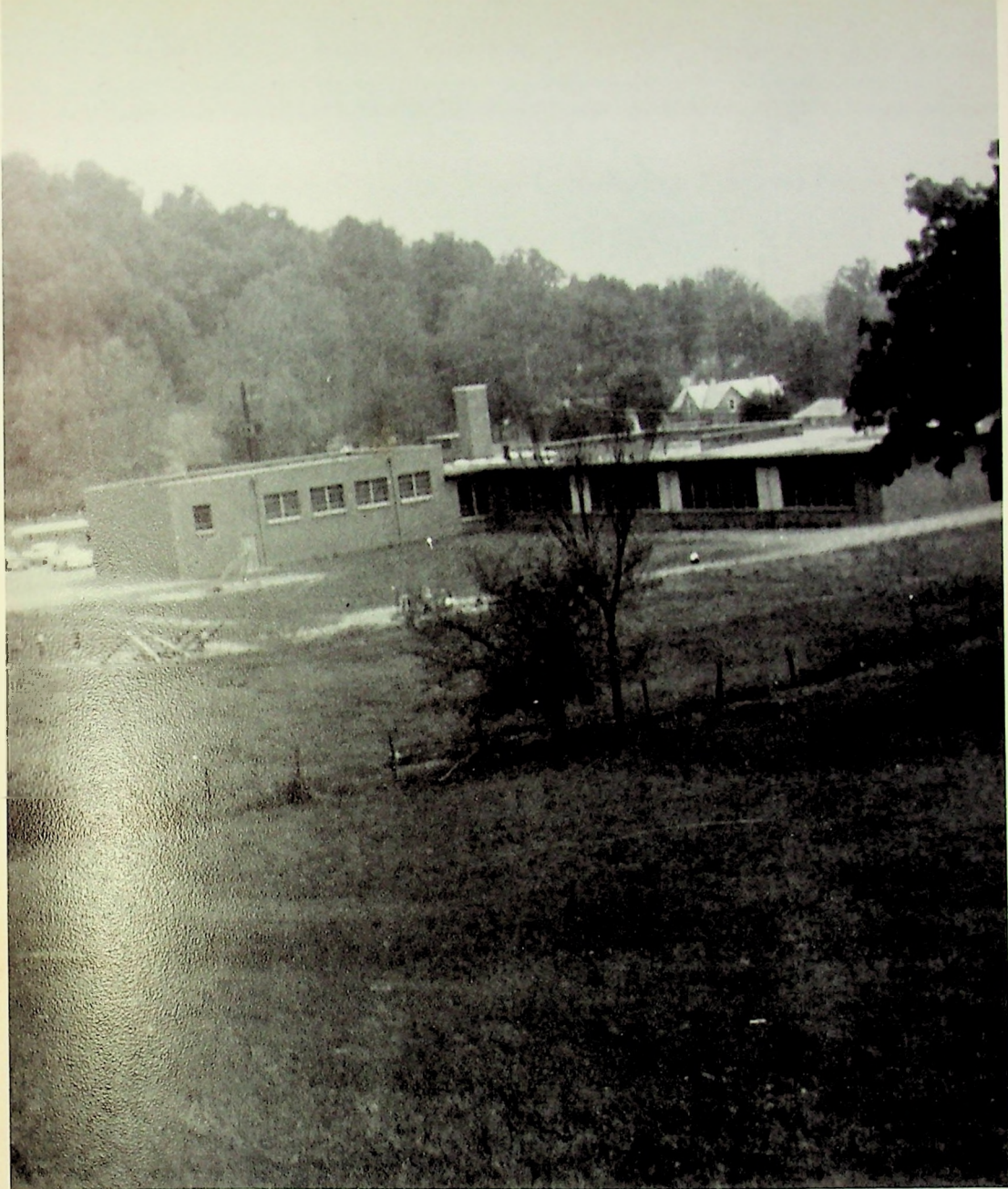

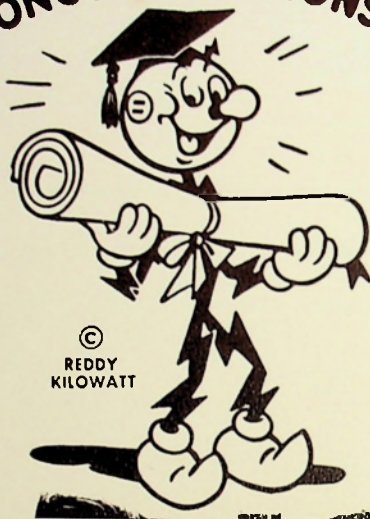
