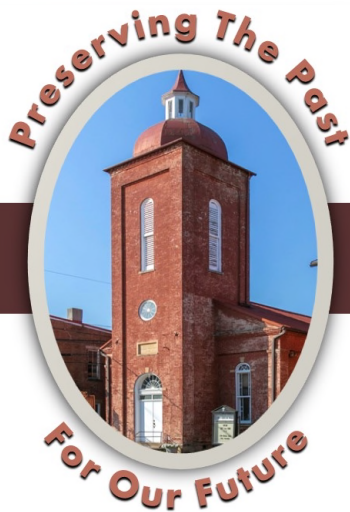

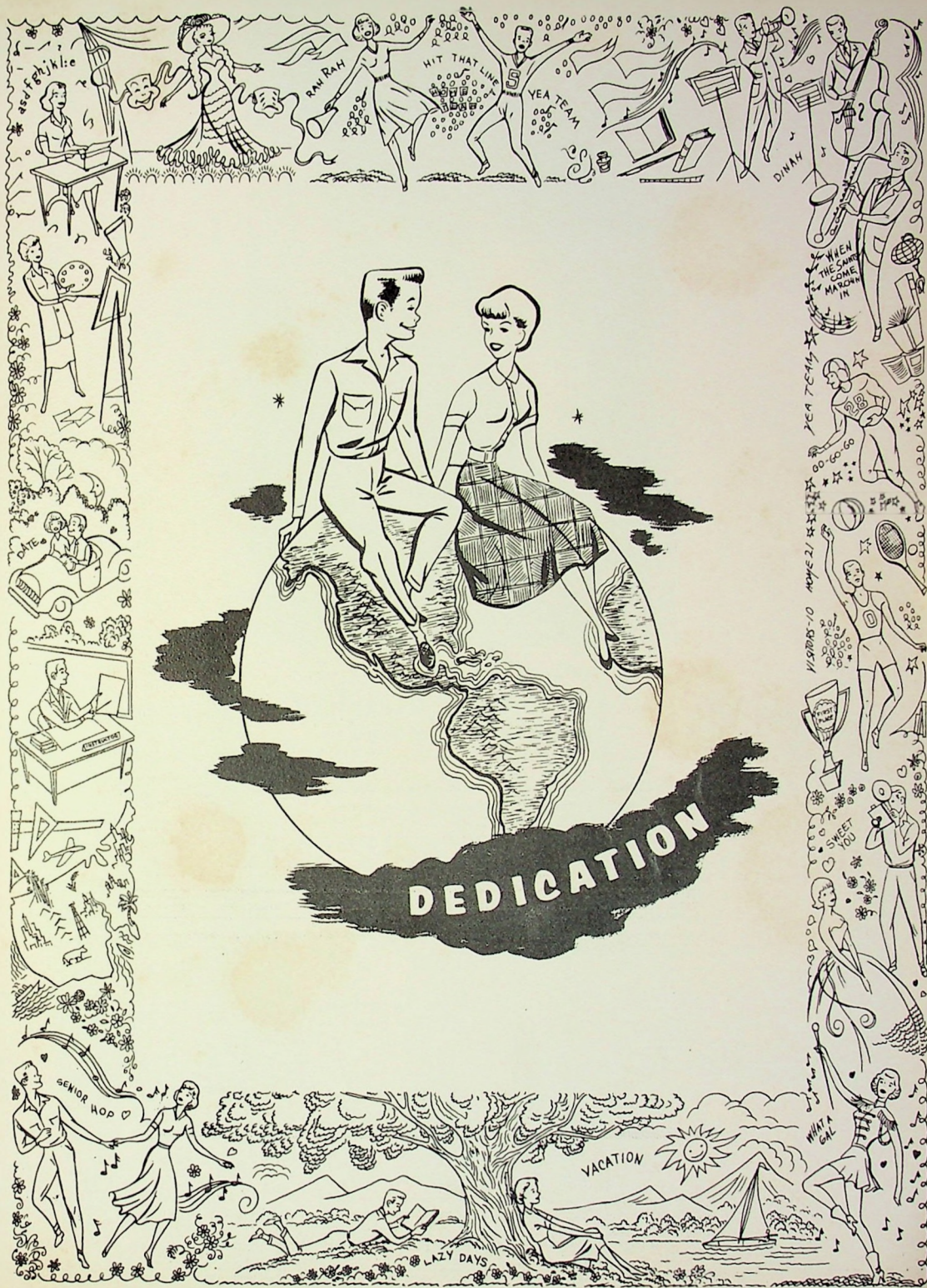

Mr. Smith has been an active member of the school board for years. Those of us who know him are witnesses to the fact that he is always willing to do anything that will lend to the betterment of our schools.

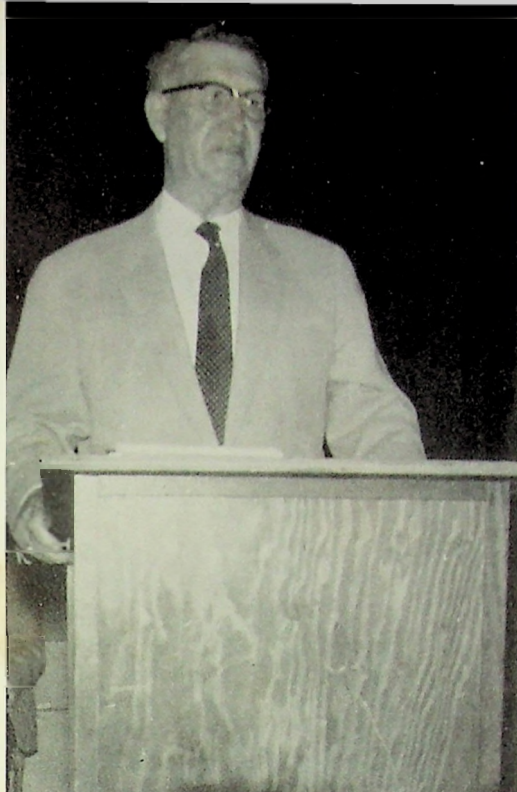

History Of Our School

The first school house was situated by the lane just west of the large maple tree in front of the old stone house where Mrs. Ethel Cutler now lives.

The second school was built in 1861 on land purchased by the township from Mr. W. H. Truesdell. This was out on the Long Fork road. It was a two room--one story building. In 1866, a bridge was built over Noname Creek, near the school house.

In the fall of 1880, a two story school (pictured above) was built on the school house lot.

This school was used until 1936, when a new four room school was built on the same lot.

This school was abandoned in 1954 when the present modern thirteen room building was built on land purchased from John Lucas, on state route 124.

Some very early teachers were: Catherine Lovett, Joseph McDougal who was killed during Morgan's Raid, Presley Adams and C. B. Smith.

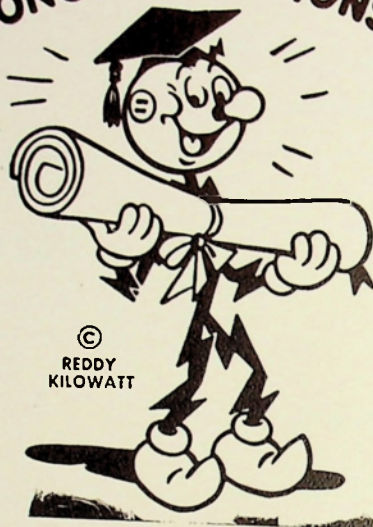
