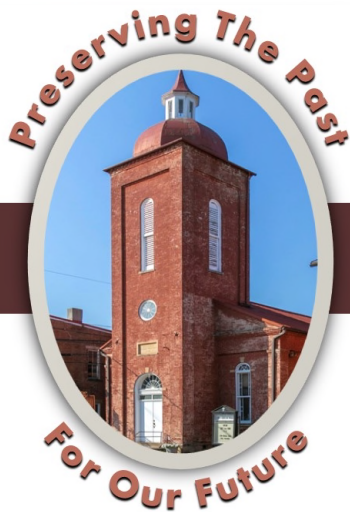

## School Years Become Memories

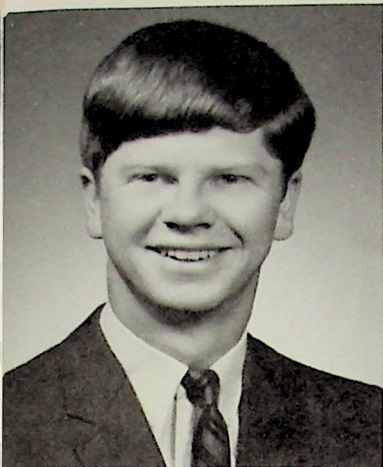
