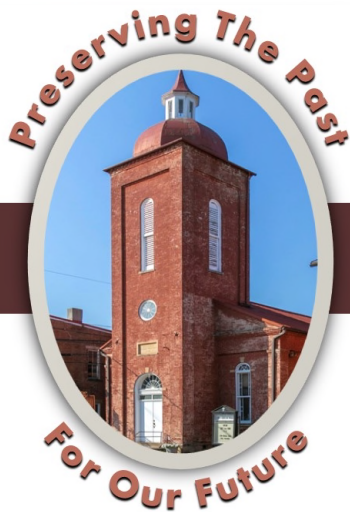



Mr. Way is always ready to give a helping hand to students or teachers who come to him with their problems. Understanding, tolerance, and patience are just a few of his many attributes.

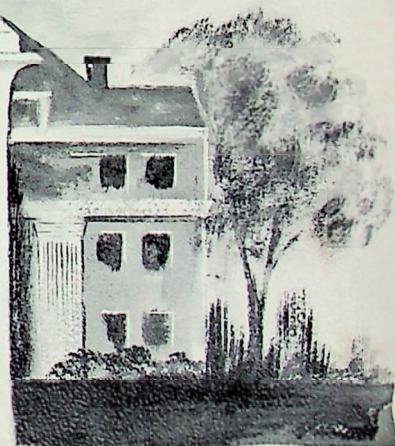
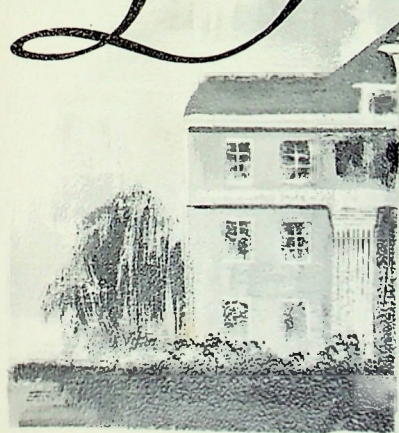

Scioto Valley Local School Board

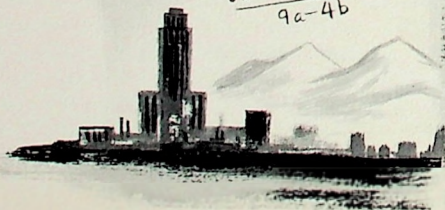
Alfred Smith, Donovan Humble, Floyd Louderback, Willard Skaggs, and Samuel Hughes

The total enrollment of these schools at this time is approximately 1500 students, with 67 teachers and 44 school employees.

Lois Swiger and Mary Dean are both bank tellers at the First National Bank of Jasper. Kenneth Spriggs is the new minister at the Jasper Church.

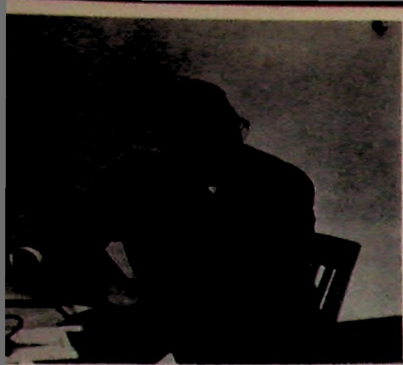

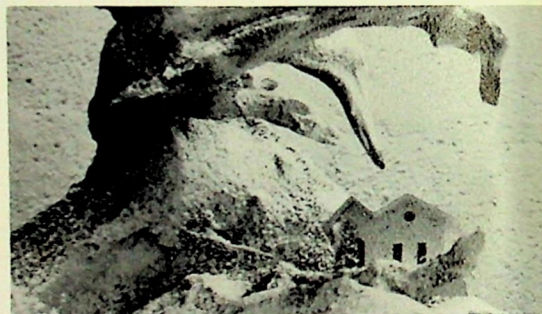

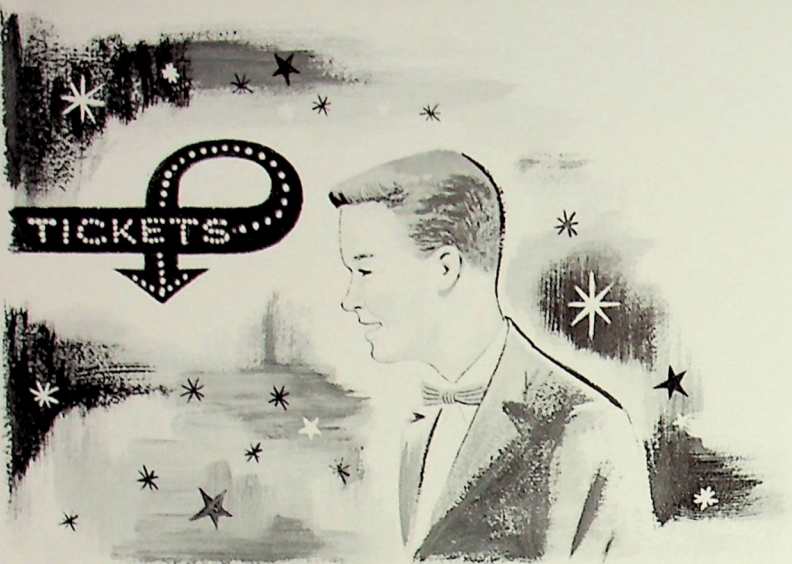




Another day - Another school year has ended at Jasper School. We hope you have enjoyed the events of the year as we have tried to record them for you in the "Jasper Jet."
