 received to our full satisfaction of *John T. Tracy of Springfield in the County of Cuyahoga*
State of Ohio

Have remised, released, and forever quit-claimed, and do by these presents for ourselves and heirs & assigns
 justly and absolutely remise, release, and for ever
 quit-claim unto the said *John T. Tracy &c.*

to his heirs and assigns for ever, all such right and title as we the said *Henry L. Edmonds*
 have or ought to have in or to certain Land contained in the public
 square situated in *Springfield near to J. Tracy's dwelling Room* on which
 has lately been erected a Building for an Academy & House of public Worship
 the quantity of Land hereby released is not to exceed two acres

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the premises unto the said *Tracy &c.* to his
 heirs and assigns, to the only use and behoof
 of the said *Tracy &c.*

heirs and assigns forever, so that neither we the said *Henry L. Edmonds* any other persons
 or persons in our name and behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right
 or title to the premises, or any part thereof, but they and every one of them shall, by these presents be ex-
 cluded and forever barred.
