Sanderson's Corners

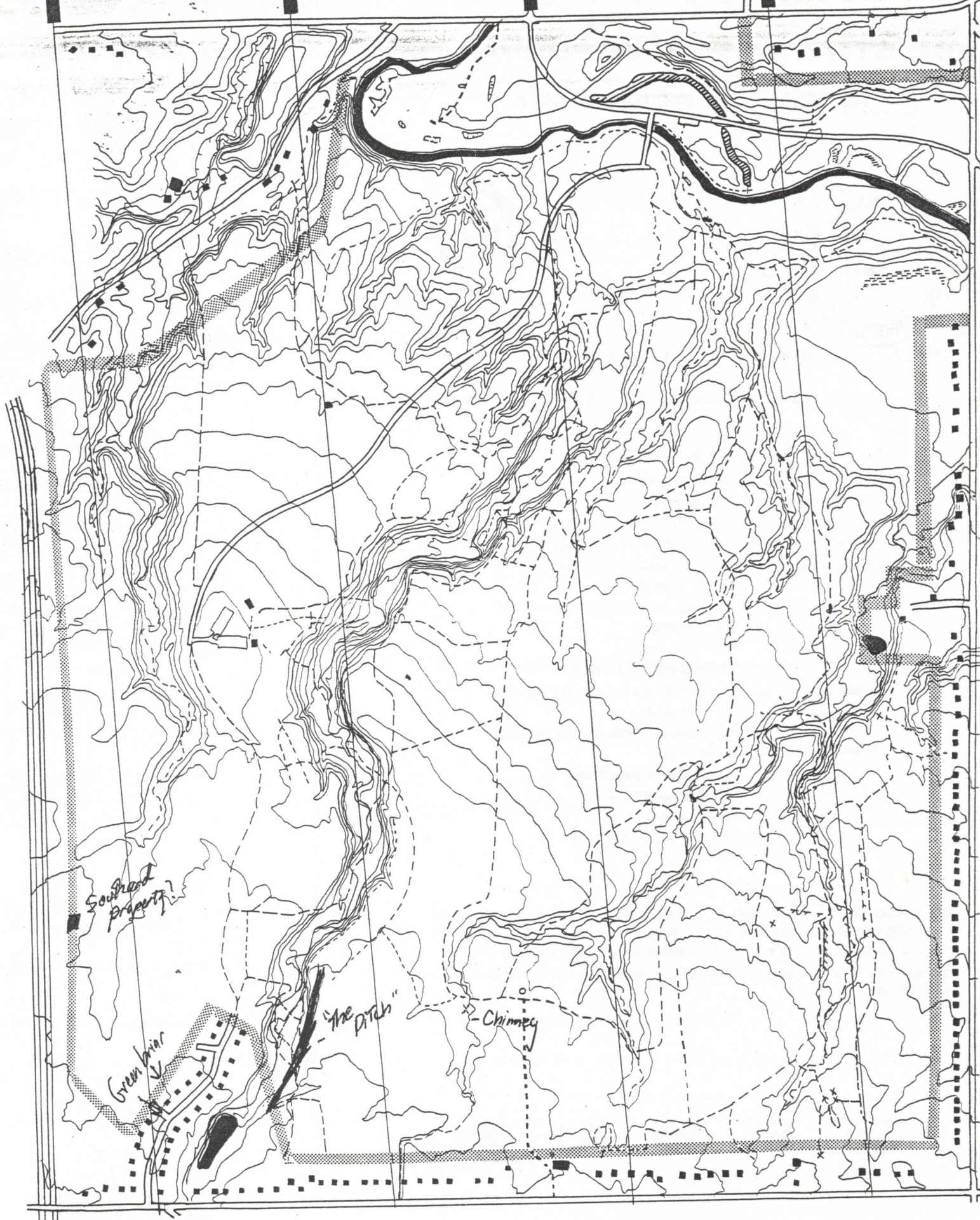
- Sanderson's Corners, named after Eri Sanderson family, arrived in 1837.
- Later home (built in 1860) still visible on south side of Drake Rd., across from Greenbriar Rd.
- Southard family settled in 1818, .5 miles north of Drake Rd. on Diagonal Rd., which ran between Strongsville and Hinckley (Hunt Rd. today.)
- Original Homestead somewhere near today's I-71.
- Apollos Southard Sr. dammed the stream flowing through his property, and started "the ditch" as a water source to a shingle mill and basket factory.
- Apollos Jr. took over in 1862, extended the ditch another 800 ft., and built another mill at the bottom of the bank. Water power dwindled, and Apollo raised the dam and water level, causing local flooding and dispute!

Maple Sugar Camps

- Two camps operated in area near chimney, one small camp until 1940 (produced about 300 gallons/year), and one larger camp which burned down in 1945 (produced about 1200 gallons/year). Chimney is remains of larger camp. Maple trees were cut down and sold in 1940s or 50s.

Slab Hollow

- Named for slabs of wood cut at mill, somewhere near today's Camp Cheerful.
- Original school and library located on old Howe Rd., today called Mill Hollow Lane. Foundation of old blacksmith shop still

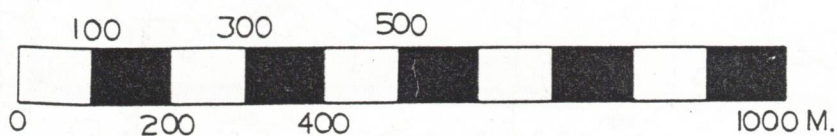
