A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DUTIES OF THE KAHO'OLAWE ISLAND RESERVE COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 6K-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended to read as follows:		
3	"§6K-6 Responsibilities and duties of the commission. The		
4	[commission shall:] general administration of the island		
5	reserve shall rest with the commission. In carrying out its		
6	duties and responsibilities, the commission:		
7	(1) [Establish] Shall establish criteria, policies, and		
8	controls for permissible uses within the island		
9	reserve;		
10	(2) [Approve] Shall approve all contracts for services and		
11	rules pertaining to the island reserve;		
12	(3) [Provide] Shall provide advice to the governor, the		
13	department, and other departments and agencies on any		
14	matter relating to the island reserve;		
15	(4) [Provide] Shall provide advice to the office of		
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1	planning and the department of the attorney general on
_	any matter relating to the federal conveyance of
•	Kaho`olawe;

- (5) [Enter] May enter into curator or stewardship agreements with appropriate Hawaiian cultural and spiritual community organizations for the perpetuation of native Hawaiian cultural, religious, and subsistence customs, beliefs, and practices for the purposes stated in section 6K-3;
- (6) [Carry] Shall carry out those powers and duties otherwise conferred upon the board of land and natural resources and the land use commission with regard to dispositions and approvals pertaining to the island reserve. All powers and duties of the board of land and natural resources and the land use commission concerning dispositions and approvals pertaining to the island reserve are transferred to the commission;
- (7) [Carry] Shall carry out those powers and duties concerning the island reserve otherwise conferred upon the county of Maui by chapter 205A. The powers and duties of the county of Maui and its agencies

1		concerning coastal zone [disposition] dispositions and
2		approvals pertaining to the island reserve are
3		transferred to the commission; [and]
4	(8)	Shall carry out those powers and duties concerning the
5		island reserve otherwise conferred upon the island
6		burial councils and the department with regard to
7		proper treatment of burial sites and human skeletal
8		remains found in the island reserve;
9	[(8)]	(9) [Adopt] Shall adopt rules in accordance with
10		chapter 91 that are necessary for the purposes of this
11		chapter and shall maintain a record of its proceedings
12		and actions[.]; and
13	(10)	May delegate to the executive director or employees of
14		the commission, by formal commission action, such
15		power and authority vested in the commission by this
16		chapter as the commission deems reasonable and proper
17		for the effective administration of this chapter."
