

Warrant of Arrest

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

Buck Wilson,

uttering a check on the First Mercer National Bank of Harrodsburg
Kentucky for Seventy Five Cents (0.75cts) and no funds to pay same,

in the County of Mercer, the 14th day of May 1931.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said Buck Wilson,

and bring him before me to be dealt with according to law.

The arresting officer may take bail in the sum of \$100.00 for the appearance
