Plaintiff, First National Bank of Harrodsburg Kentucky, states that it is a Banking Corporation organized and doing business under the laws of the United States and the State of Kentucky with its principal place of business in Harrodsburg, Kentucky.

It states that the defendant, L.C. Chambers, by his promissory note, dated, Feb. 7th., 1927 which he executed and delivered to this plaintiff promised and agreed to pay to plaintiff the sum of \$122.50 with interest from date until paid.

Plaintiff says that said note matured on the 7th., day of August 1927; that no part of the interest or principal has been paid; that said amount is just; that this is an action upon a contract being a contract to pay money on a note; that it believes it ought to recover the full amount of the note; that defendant has no property in this state subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy and pay said indebtedness and the collection of the demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and return of no property found.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for judgment against the defendant in the sum^{of} of \$122.50 with interest from Feb. 7th., 1927; for costs of this action and for a general order of attachment of defen-
