

BAIL BOND.

THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, MERCER COUNTY COURT.

The Defendant A. F. Mitchell being in custody
of the Sheriff Fraunfelter of Mercer County, charged with the offense
of Break of the Peace and
being admitted to bail in the sum of One hundred Dollars:

THEREFORE, we A. F. Mitchell Principal
and John M. Lewis Fraunfelter Surety, of Mercer County, Kentucky,
do hereby undertake that the above named A. F. Mitchell
shall appear in the Mercer County Court, on the 17th
day of May 21 at 2 o'clock p.m., to answer said charge, and shall at all times
render himself amendable to the order and process of said Court in the
prosecution of said charge, and if convicted shall render himself in execu-
tion thereof; or if he shall fail to perform either of these conditions, that
we will pay to the Commonwealth of Kentucky the sum of \$100 00
Dollars.
