

## Mercer Mother Hears From Prisoner Son

Letters have been received this week by Mrs. I. W. Rue of Harrodsburg from two of her five sons in service, one of whom is a prisoner of war. He is Lieutenant Arch Rue, a prisoner of the Japanese in Philippine Camp No. I, who wrote that he is well and hopes to be home soon.

The other son, Electrician's Mate first class Insco Rue, in San Francisco, California, after long duty in the South Pacific, says, he expects soon to spend a fifteen-day leave at home.

Other sons of Mrs. Rue with the armed forces are Captain (Skip) Rue, prisoner of the Japanese in the Philippines; Leslie Rue, United States Marine Corps, and Clarence Rue with the Merchant Marine.
