To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal, or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

has committed the offense of making, uttering publishing and delivering a check for the payment of money upon a bank without having funds in said bank at the time to pay same and knowing that he had no funds on deposit there to pay same

You are therefore commanded to arrest said Ed Watkins and bring him before me to be dealt with according to law.
