The Court being advised adjudges that plaintiff recover of defendant \$116.78 with 6% interest from this date together with all his costs herein expended, and the counter-claim of the defendant is dismissed, except to the extent allowed in arriving at the about amount due plaintiff.

The Court further sustains the grounds of attachment herein, and adjudges that plaintiff has a lien upon the property attached consisting of one Buick Model 1912 Automobile, being the same machine sold to debt by plaintiff, and plaintiff is awarded a lien thereon for his debt interest and costs and adjudged entitled to a sale thereof to satisfy the same.

John Morgan, Sheriff is ordered and directed to sell said automobile on a credit of three months, at or near the court house door in Harrodsburg, Ky on a date to be selected by him, after first advertising the sale by inserting in a ^{weekly} newspaper published in Harrodsburg, Ky for not less than three consecutive weekly issues thereof next preceding the date of sale, a notice containing the amount to be raised, the terms and time of sale, with a description of the property, and he will post a like notice one at the court house door and one at three other public places in the vicinity of the place of sale for not less than fifteen days next preceding the date of sale.

For the purchase money arising at said sale he will take bond payable to himself, bearing legal interest from date of sale until paid,
