It is adjudged that plaintiffs recover of defendant J. A. Green, \$167.86 with 6% interest thereon from May 1, 1910 until paid with their costs herein expended; and it is further ordered and adjudged that the grounds of attachment be and they are confirmed. Plaintiffs are adjudged a lien upon one-half of about ten acres of tobacco grown on the farm of Dr. E. G. Guttery, but their lien is subject to the claim of the landlord thereon.

It is adjudged that E. G. Guttery, the garnishee, sell said tobacco in the customary manner and collect the money it brings. Said Guttery will then report to this Court in writing the amount said tobacco brings, with the amounts of his claims thereon as landlord.

The questions between said Green and the landlord, are reserved for future adjudication, after the report of the garnishee is filed.
