The plaintiff, Vernon Cloyd, says that the defendant, Strot Dean, is indebted to him in the following amounts and for purposes annexed thereto: For rent \$50.00; for shucking corn \$30.00; for use of engine \$16.25; for coal \$7.00; for telephone \$5.90; for grocery account paid to Hade Smith \$87.04.

Total \$195.19.

He says that this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just, due and unpaid and that he ought to recover thereon said amounts above given with interest from this date totalling \$195.19, and that defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtain judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same.

Wherefore he prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$195.19 and all the costs of this action and for all relief to which he is entitled including a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant. He prays for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled special, general and proper-
