

Warrant of Arrest.

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal, or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that Kie Cummins and Mary Cummins

has committed the offense of petit larceny by stealing chickens of less value than \$2.00

in the County of Mercer, the day of March, 1919.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said Kie Cummins and Mary Cummins
