

BAIL BOND.

THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, MERCER COUNTY COURT.

The Defendant, Spence Yeast, being in custody of the Sheriff of Mercer County, charged with the offense of Engaging in a Game of Craps and being admitted to bail in the sum of One hundred Dollars

THEREFORE, we and John Yeast Surety of Mercer County, Kentucky do hereby undertake that the above named Spence Yeast shall appear in the Mercer County Court, on the 17 day of April 1919, to answer to said charge, and shall at all times render himself amenable to the order and process of said Court in the prosecution of said charge, and if convicted shall render himself in execution thereof; or if he shall fail to perform either of these conditions, that we will pay to the Commonwealth of Kentucky the sum of 100.00 Dollars.
