The defendants First National Bank of Harrodsburg, Ky, and
First Mercer National Bank of Harrodsburg, Ky, will take notice that
on Tuesday, July 19th 1932, the petitioners will move the Honorable
Judge of the Mercer County Court, at his office in Harrodsburg, Ky,
at about 9 o'clock A M, to remove the said First National Bank of
Harrodsburg, Ky as Executor of I E Whiteneck, and to require the said
First National Bank as such Executor to make full settlements of ~~xxxx~~
its accounts,; and for the appointment of a successor to the said Exe-
cutor as Administrator with the will annexed of the said I E Whiteneck
estate, in this- that the petitioners being legatees under the will of
the said I E Whiteneck aver that the said First National Bank of Har-
rodsburg, Ky, was on Jany 7th 1929 duly appointed and qualified as
Executor under the will of the said I E Whiteneck and executed bond as
said Executor with its capital stock as security; that before its ap-
pointment as Executor it had qualified as ~~xxxxxx~~ Committee for the said I E White
neck, and that upon the death of the said Whiteneck qualified as aforesaid,
