Plaintiff, Oscar Brown, states that defendant is indebted to him in the sum of \$9.85, on account; that said account is just, due and unpaid, and though demand has been made upon defendant, he has failed and refused and still fails and refuses to pay said account or any part of same.

Wherefore, etc.

Plaintiff states that this is an account upon a contract, being a contract to pay money upon account; that said account is just; that plaintiff believes he ought to recover the full amount of account, to wit, \$9.85; that defendant has no property in this state subject to execution, or not enough thereof to satisfy or pay said account; and that collection of same will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and the return of no property found.

WHEREFORE plaintiff prays judgment against defendant for the sum of \$9.85, for the cost of this action and for a general order of attachment against the property of defendant, including a summons against the Garnishee, KY-Hydro Electric Company; and prays further for all other relief to which he may appear to be entitled.
