We command you that you take Charles Burns if he be found within your county, and him safely keep, so that you have his body before our Judge of our Mercer Circuit Court, the *17* day of *Nov* 1928 to satisfy E. D. Lay the sum of \$500.00 with interest thereon from Octo 1927, which the said Lay hath recovered against him for damages; also the sum of \$ *25⁰⁰* which to the said Lay in the same court was adjudged for his costs; and that you have the same at Harrodsburg, Ky on the *17* day of *Nov* 1928 to satisfy and pay the said Lay his damages and costs aforesaid, and have then and there this writ.
