

They that by deed dated March 7, 1907, recorded in D.B. 76 page 428 of the records of the Mercer County Clerks Office, Etta McCrosky and H.N.McCrosky her husband, Chas. P. Thompson and Mary R. Thompson his wife, Sue M. Cole and Sam T. Cole her husband conveyed to Eliza Jane Thompson, widow of Sam Thompson decd. during her natural life with remainder to the said Chas. P. Thompson, Etta McCrosky and Sue M. Cole the following described real estate, situated in the county of Mercer and State of Kentucky, towit;

First tract consisted of sixty three acres (63) more or less on the waters of Shawnee Run and bounded as follows: On the north and west by the land of H.N.McCrosky and the land conveyed by the heirs of Sam Thompson to the said H.N.McCrosky, and the place of Ab Lay heirs; on the south by the land conveyed by the widow and heirs of Sam Thompson decd. to Chas. P. Thompson, and on the east by the second tract, being the old Abigail Hendren place and conveyed to Sam Thompson decd., by Joseph Stopher and wife by deed dated Feb. 24, 1865, and recorded in D.B. 35 page 343, of the Mercer County Clerks Office, and by Elias Thompson by deed dated Feb 24, 1865, and recorded in D.B. 34 page 134, of said office, and by Henry Thompson by deed dated Feb 11, 1867, recorded in D.B. 37 page 69 of said office, and by Isaac Hendren and wife by deed dated Aug 1873, recorded in D.B. 42 page 502 of said office. From the said tract is excepted a grave yard of about $\frac{1}{4}$ acre, which was reserved.

The second tract adjoins the above tract and bounded as follows, towit: Beginning in the center of the Warwick road and running N 50 W 7.50 chs to corner of Sam Thompson decd. (first tract) thence S $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W to stone corner to Sam Thompson in line of Thos. McCrosky (C.P.Thompson) thence S 50° E 7.50 chs in line of Thos. McCrosky (C.P.Thompson) To stone in J.K.Slaughters line (now Dan Condor), thence N $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 16 chs to the Beginning, containing 11 acres 3 rods and 37 poles, being the same tract of land conveyed to Sam Thompson decd by Wm. Hamilton and wife by deed dated March 7, 1854.
