The plaintiff, J.Brummett, states that the defendant, Abe Donehi, is indebted to him in the sum of \$62.23 for hogs sold to him at his special instance and request and received by him under said contract of sale. He says said debt is due, unpaid, though payment has been repeatedly demanded; that this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just and he should recover thereon said amount.

He says that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's claim and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same.

Wherefore he prays for a judgment for \$62.25 and all the costs of this action and for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant including a summons against the Burley Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association as garnishee. He prays for all relief.
