BAIL BOND.

THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, MERCER COUNTY COURT.

The Defendant Charley Pulliam being in custody

of Arresting to Commit and
being admitted to bail in the sum of Twenty Five Dollars:

THEREFORE, we Chas Pulliam Principal
and Chas Pulliam Surety, of Mercer County, Kentucky,
do hereby undertake that the above named Char Pulliam
shall appear in the Mercer County Court, on the 21st
day of April 1920, to answer said charge, and shall at all times
render himself amenable to the order and process of said Court in the
prosecution of said charge, and if convicted shall render himself in execu-
tion thereof; or if he shall fail to perform either of these conditions, that
we will pay to the Commonwealth of Kentucky the sum of 25.00
Dollars.
