The Plaintiff Harrodsburg Implement Company, states that it is a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Kentucky.

That the defendant Scott Parker by his promissory note, which he executed and delivered to the Plff dated July 2nd 1921 agreed and promised on or before the 1st day of May 1922 to pay to the plaintiff \$100. with interest thereon from date, no part of which has ever been paid. A copy of said note is filed herewith.

Wherefore it prays judgment against the defendant for \$100. with interest as aforesaid and for its cost and for all proper relief.

Paragraph 2, The plaintiff reaffirming the allegations in the former paragraph and making same a part of this paragraph as fully as if copied herein, for other cause of action against defendant says, that on May 1st 1921 by his promissory note which the Deft executed and delivered to the plaintiff, he agreed and promised on or before the 1st day of Aug 1921 to pay to the Plff \$62.85 with interest thereon from date until paid, no part of which has ever been paid. A copy of said note is filed herewith.

Wherefore it prays judgment for the said sum with interest and for its cost and for all proper relief.
