

Whereas at the October term of the Mercer Circuit Court 1931,
Howard Combs was convicted and sentenced to a jail sentence
of Forty days in the Mercer County jail and whereas the County
Court has in lieu of the said punishment at hard labor in the
said County Jail has entered an order that the said Howard Combs
be hired out to Ed. Combs for a period of Forty days and that
the said Ed Combs is to have the benefit of the said Labor of
Howard Combs during said period.

Now therefore we Ed. Combs and Sam Thompson, surety bind ourselves
to the Commonwealth of Kentucky that we will provide proper feed
and lodging for the prisoner, Howard Combs and shall pay the
sum of seventy-five cents per day for a period of forty days.
