

MERCER COUNTY COURT

IN RE: HOWARD COMBS,

ORDER

Howard Combs, having heretofore convicted of the offense of breach of the Peace in the Mercer Circuit Court at the <sup>and given a sentence of forty days in jail</sup> October Term, 1930, /and having prayed an appeal and having dismissed the said appeal, and having been arrested by the Sheriff of Mercer and turned over to the Jailer of Mercer County; Upon Motion of Ed Combs it is ordered that the said prisoner, Howard Combs, be bound out and hired out to Ed Combs for a period of Forty Days to be worked out at hard labor for said Ed Combs in lieu of working and being confined in the Mercer County Jail; It is ordered that The said Ed Combs pay into the treasury of Mercer County seventy five cents per day for a period of forty days; The Said Ed Combs will execute a good bond to secure the payment of the said seventy five cents per day and to insure the proper feeding and clothing of the prisoner ~~xxxxxx~~ and the jailer is ordered to release and turn over to Ed Combs the said prisoner.
