
The plaintiff, Linda Lunsford, states that defendant Lester Pennington is indebted to her in the sum of \$ 92.00 for board and lodging she furnished defendant at his special instance and request and for which he promised and agreed to pay for. She states that said amount is now due and owing and although payment has often been requested that the defendant has refused and still refuses to pay same.

She states that defendant starting boarding with her March 1, 1924 and continued to board and lodge with her until about the first of June 1924 and that defendant promised and agreed to pay ~~for~~ one dollar ( \$ 1.00 ) per day for said board and lodging.

She states that defendant is entitled to a credit of \$ 25.00 ~~per~~ on said account and also to a credit of \$ 13.00.

Plaintiff states that G. H. Pennington, is agent for said Lester Pennington.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays for judgment against defendant in the sum of \$ 92.00 minus the above mentioned credits; for her costs herein and for all further and proper relief she may appear to be entitled to.
