The Plaintiff Willie Milburn, states that the property claimed by him in this action is a black Jersey heifer about 18 months old and a calf by her side about two weeks old and of the value of Sixty Dollars. The Plaintiff states that said heifer and calf is his property and that he is entitled to the immediate possession thereof and that same are being wrongfully detained by the Defendant. Plaintiff says that said heifer and calf were not taken under any execution or attachment against him or distress warrant, nor under any order or judgment of the Court against same; he says that this cause of action has accrued within one year last past. He says that the value of said heifer is \$50.00 and of the calf is \$10.00.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for an order of delivery for said heifer and ~~XX~~ calf, but if same cannot be delivered then he prays for a judgment for the sum of sixty dollars and his costs herein expended.
