The Plaintiff, the Commonwealth of Kentucky by R. J. O'Mahony, duly appointed, qualified and acting Revenue Agent for the State at Large, states that the deceased, Nancy Stewart, was at the time of her death a resident of Mercer County, Kentucky; that by the will of said decedent of record in Will Book __ Page __, in the Mercer County Court Clerk's office at Harrodsburg, Kentucky, the said decedent bequeathed to her niece, Sudie Hatchett, one-half of her estate; that in the settlement of said estate the said Sudie Hatchett received the sum of \$1502.

Plaintiff states that by and under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky in force at the time of said decedent's death, at all times since and now in force, the aforesaid bequest except \$500. thereof exempt by law, is subject to the inheritance tax of five per cent to the State of Kentucky on each \$100. of its fair cash value as provided by the law of the State of Kentucky enacted in the year 1906; plaintiff states that said tax has not been paid; that more than eighteen months have elapsed since the death of said decedent; that no steps whatever have been taken by the defendant herein towards the payment of said tax and the same is now delinquent.

Plaintiff states that there is due the Commonwealth of Kentucky interest on said tax at the rate of ten per cent per annum from the date of the death of said decedent until said tax is paid to the proper official as provided by law. Plaintiff states that the Revenue Agent, R. J. O'Mahony, instituting this action, is
