The defendant Kie Cummins for Answer to plaintiffs petition herein denies that he is indebted to the plaintiff in the sum of \$116,50 for goods, wares and merchandise sold and delivered to him at his special instance and request during the year 1920 and up to and including March, 1921; he denies that said claim is just and unpaid and that plaintiff should recover said amount with interest and costs; he denies that he has not property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiffs demand and demands of defendants creditors and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in ^{obtaining} ~~obtaining~~ judgment or a return of no property found. Wherefore &c.

Par.....2. Plaintiff reaffirming the statements in the foregoing paragraph and making it a part hereof says that he is indebted to the plaintiff in the sum of \$22,00 and that in the year 1921 and before said time the plaintiff refused this defendant credit and that at the time he refused him further credit that he only owed the plaintiff the said sum of \$22.00.

Wherefore plaintiff prays that the Court adjudge that he is indebted to the plaintiff in the sum of \$22,00 and no further sum, for his costs and whatever relief he may appear entitled to.
