The Plff, C.L.Sims, that A.A Woods died testate in Mercer County, Kentucky, on the \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_ 1916; and that his will was duly probated in the Mercer County Court and the Defts T.C Woods and T J Hudson, were duly and legally appointed Executors of said will; that they duly qualified as such and are now acting in said capacity.

He says that on the 24th day of July 1915, the decedent A A Woods, by his promissory notes, which he executed and delivered to the Plff, agreed and promised 12 months thereafter to pay to the Plff the sum of \$68.00, no part of which has ever been paid. He says that said note with affidavit, as required by law, was presented to the Defendants and payment thereon demanded and that they refused to pay the same. He files said note and affidavit herein and prays judgment on the said note and for his cost and for all proper relief.

Paragraph 2-

The Plff reaffirming the allegations in the first paragraph and making them a part of this paragraph, for other claim against the ~~Deft~~ Deft's state, that during the year 1914 and 1915 he did work and labor for the decedent, ~~AA~~ A.A Woods to the amount of \$34.75, and that he lent the said Woods money to the amount of \$4.00 all of which is shown in an itemized account filed herewith. He says that the said Woods agreed and promised to pay for said work and labor the prices charged and that the said work and labor was done for the said Woods at his special instance and request; that he borrowed the said money from the Plff and agreed and promised to
