

pay the same, and that no part of said account for work and labor and
borrowed money has ever been paid. He says that he presented said
account duly proven by the affidavit of the Plff and of C.H Sims,
as required by law, and demanded payment thereof, but that the Dfts
refused to pay the same.

Wherefore he prays judgment against the Defendants for
the said sum of \$38.75 with interest thereon from Oct 7th 1916.
He prays judgment as in first paragraph in the said sum of \$68. with
interest thereon from July 24th 1916, and prays for his cost and for
all proper relief.
