The Plff, C L Sims, for reply to the second paragraph of the Defendants' answer, denies that the items "one stove flue \$5. or the item, made shutter for well 50 cts, or, buolding wire fence 20 rods, \$5., or, bale and wire fence 40 panels, \$4., or any of said items accrued or existed more than five years before the death of the decdedent or before the filing of the suit. They Be denies that the Statute of limitation applies.

Plff further says that the ~~Defendant~~ decedent with in a few weeks before his death agreed and promised to pay the said account including the said items.

For answer to the third paragrapg of Defts answer, Plff denies that during the year 1913, 1914, 19145, or 1916, the deceased, A A Woods furnished to the Plaintiff team or Horses or wagon, or that he furnished him horse or horses at other times for any length of time. He denies that the deceased furnished the Plff either wagon or team at any time for which any charge was to be made, or that he furnished to the Plff wagon or teams or horse in my amount, or at any time, for which the Plff did not pay in money or work. He denies that any wagons or teams or horses were furnished to the Plff to the value of \$100. or any sum.

For reply to paragraph 4, ~~he~~ he denies that the Defts are the holderson owners of the note sued on, or that they are entitled to to plead said note as an offset in this action.
