The defendant having been duly summoned and failing to answer it is

adjudged that the plaintiff recover of the defendant \$136.85 with 6% interest thereon from July 11, 1923 until paid and that ~~him~~ to secure the payment thereof is had a lien on a buggy and set of harness, the same as sold by plaintiff to the defendant.

It is adjudged that the plaintiff is entitled to a sale of said personal property to satisfy said judgment; the Sheriff of Mercer County is directed to take possession of said personal property and sell the same at public

auction at the Court House door in Harrodsburg, Kentucky at some date to be fixed by him on a credit of 3 months; before making said sale he will cause ~~it~~ to be advertised by posting a notice containing the time,

place and terms of sale and a description of the property at the Court House door in Harrodsburg, Kentucky for not less than ten days next preceding the date of sale; he will have said property appraised as is required in sales of like property under execution and in the event said property is appraised for \$100.00 or more he will insert a similar notice in some newspaper of general circulation published in Harrodsburg, Kentucky for not less than three consecutive issues thereof next preceding the date of sale.

The defendant and all persons claiming through him are ordered to surrender said property to the Sheriff and a certified copy of this judgment will be authority for the Sheriff to take possession thereof.
