

Warrant of Arrest

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

E Sanders

had no funds to meet same with,
in the County of Mercer, the 16th day of MAY 1931.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said E Sanders,

and bring him before me to be dealt with according to law.
