The plaintiffs, J. A. Ballard and G. M. Ballard, state that they are partners doing business under the firm name of Ballard Bros., with principal office and place of business at Harrodsburg, in Mercer County, Kentucky.

The plaintiffs state that at October term, 1922, they recovered a judgment against the defendant, M. J. Johnson, in the Quarterly Court of Mercer County, Kentucky, for the sum of Thirteen Dollars and Fifty cents (\$13.50), with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent. per annum from October 4, 1922, and the further sum of Three Dollars and Forty-five cents (\$3.45) as their costs in said action, and that on the 11th day of May, 1923, they had issued from the office of the judge of said court an execution on said judgment for the amount thereof, with costs as aforesaid, which execution was placed in the hands of S. W. Kennedy, then Sheriff of Mercer County, to do execution thereof; that on the 17th day of May, 1923, the said execution was returned by the said sheriff to the office whence it issued endorsed: "No property found in Mercer County, to make the within or any part thereof.
