Plaintiff, a Kentucky corporation, states that the defendant is indebted to him by his promisory note copy of which is attached the sum of \$78.40 with interest from Jan 1, 1915 until paid and on which he has paid only \$10.75 Nov. 2, 1914, and \$5 Aug. 7, 1915.

That to secure said note the defendant on Nov. 2, 1907 executed to it a mortgage on one Beaumont Rubber tire buggy set of harness one bay gelding 7 years old, called Billy, one black Jersy cow 3 years old called Blacky, which mortgage was duly acknowledged and recorded, and the original of same is filed herewith as a part hereof; that by reason thereof it has a lien on said personality and is entitled to have same enforced by sale of sufficient thereof to pay said note interest and costs.

Wherefore it prays judgment for its debt interest and costs and the enforcement of said lien.
